Minutes of the Governance Council

September 18, 2014

- 1. Susan Dinan, vice-chair of the Senate, formally charged the Governance Council, and reviewed the charges regarding Emeritus Status and Elections Council in some detail.
- 2. Jackson and Nagaraj were nominated as co-chairs of the Governance Council, and they were unanimously elected.
- 3. Vovchuk volunteered to be secretary.
- 4. Duffy reviewed the progress made on the issue of Emeritus qualifications and what remains to be discussed. He also noted that two new questions regarding Emeritus qualifications had been raised:
 - a. Should there be a "statute of limitations" on an Emeritus nomination? That is to say, can a retired faculty member be nominated for Emeritus status no matter how long ago they retired?
 - b. Should there be any restrictions on who in a candidate's department is permitted to vote on the matter? Should there be rules that only department faculty who have known/worked with/worked with for a certain number of years be permitted to vote?
- 5. The Council reviewed the Emeritus nomination of Candidate A. Duffy and Chauhan spoke in strong support of Candidate A. Duffy will write up a proposal for the next meeting.
- 6. The Council discussed the Emeritus nomination of Candidate B. The Council decided the resume should be brought up to date (as of the date of retirement) and composed in a more professional manner before Candidate B will be considered. Jackson will contact Candidate B's department and give them the opportunity to rectify the situation.
- 7. Nagaraj will send a Doodle poll to schedule the next meeting.
