Charges for Academic Standards Council

Standing Charges:

- 1. Review and recommend policy for the adoption, implementation and enforcement of educational and academic standards.
- 2. Review and recommend policy for the adoption, implementation and enforcement of educational and academic standards in curricular issues.
- 3. Liaise with university officials responsible for all academic policy matters to conduct an ongoing review of their effectiveness.

Additional Charges for 2007-8:

- 1. Organize a University forum on Academic Integrity and the Honor code. Use the results of the forum to refine the revised versions of the Academic Integrity and Honor Code policies. Present an Honor Code proposal to the Senate by February 26, 2008.
- 2. Report to the Senate on the success of the current Academic Integrity Violations reporting system and recommend changes, if required.
- 3. Establish academic standards for internships and online courses.
